



Capacity Building: There is more in you





There is more in you:

The aim of the project is to transfer the concept of outdoor education and to share best practices about the positive influences of the method on unemployed youth, to youth workers. During the 2 year long project OB Romania as coordinator and OB Belgium, OB Brazil, OB India Hymalaia works together. The actions of the project are:

- -kick of meeting: the project team met in Belgium and created the working athmosphare, the action plan of the project
- -Training of Trainers 20 trainers will develop their hard and soft skills in order to be able to work more efficient with unemployed young persons
- -Youth Exchanges in Brazil and in India: the trainers will practice their gained skills during the TOT
- -Conference: to disseminate the know hows and the results of the project The project is financed by European Union trough Erasmus+ program.

Generation Europe:

The goal of the project is to promote the active citizenship among minimum 150 European youngsters. We contribute towards a confident and inclusive European citizenship. The whole project is coordinated by the German youth organization the IBB. The youth network created in the frame of the project includes 30 youth organizations from 15 different European countries. Each partnership is composed from 3 NGO-s, one from German and the 2 from another European country. In our case the partnership includes Germany, Estonia and Romania.

From each country 9 youngsters and 3 group leaders are working permanently in national and international level.

At international level in each year we organize a 10 day youth encounter for the youngsters, with the goal to develop the active citizenship skills of the youngsters and to support each other: 2018-Germany, 2019-Romania, 2020-Estonia.

In national level each national group identify a relevant local community problem and with the help of the learned civil activism methods try to resolve the situation. We encourage the youngsters in the cooperation with the politicians and other relevant stakeholders. The Romanian participants are from the Bolyai Farkas High school from Tg. Mures. They started to work on local level with enthusiasm. Their goal is to help their school colleagues in the carrier choice.

The project is financed by European Union trough Erasmus+ program, the Stiftung Mercator and the German Guvernament.

Heart:

This is an Erasmus+ KA2 project to increase the quality of adult education and training by developing adult educators competences, awareness and knowledge linked to work engagement using a new training method – the synergy of outdoor experiential education and art methodologies. Our trainers who took part in this project experienced the 3 methodologies in the frame of the 10 days TC. Than they understood and practiced how to create sequences from the combined methodologies.

From Us To You International

The main goal of the project is to empower disadvantaged youngsters through the potential of volunteering and experiential education. The program empowers them to take proactive steps towards their community, thereby becoming positive contemporary role models. Structure of the project: team building, planning, field visit, volunteer action, closing. In Romania, the programs take place between October 2019-March 2020, and the international programs in 2021.

The closing phase of the program was organized in the period of March 5th to – 8th in Sovata. It was a special closing program, because we celebrated the success of the young people and discussed how they would use in the future their gained experiences. The closing is also a new beginning: we have presented the future local and international events for 2020, which hopefully could take place in the second half of the year. The young people continue the project with new enthusiasm.

We would like to thank the cooperation to Maltese Charity Service from Romania, especially to the team from Satu Mare and Sf. Gheorghe. Coordinating partner is Élményakadémia Egyesület from Hungary. The project is co-financed by the European Union trough Erasmus+program.

Volunteers for Solidarity:

The goal of the project is to develop social and civic skills among young people from Transylvania through outdoor programs in the period April 2020 and August 2022, when we host young ESC (European Solidarity Corps) volunteers from abroad, who in their turn will develop their initiation skills and entrepreneurship skills. The 9 international volunteer came from: United Kingdom, Poland, Hungary, Latvia, Spain, Italy and Malta. During their volunteering they learnt in theory and in practice about the outdoor and experiential education, about our culture and share with us their fresh ideas, energies and enriched with an intercultural value our organization. The project is co-financed by the European Union through the ESC program.
